Order under section 323

TEMPORARY WATER RESTRICTIONS - GROUNDWATER EXTRACTION FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES

All aquifers or parts of aquifers underlying Blue Mountains City Council Local Government Area

PURSUANT to section 323 of the *Water Management Act 2000*, I, PHIL KOPERBERG MP, Minister for Climate Change, Environment and Water, on being satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest to do so because of water shortage, do by this Order direct that the taking of water pursuant to basic landholder rights under s52 of the *Water Management Act 2000* from those water sources listed in Schedule 1 of this Order is restricted as set out in the Schedule 2 of this Order.

This Order takes effect on the date it is first broadcast and will continue until 31 December 2008 unless it is repealed by Order before that date.

SCHEDULE 1 – Water Sources

All aquifers or parts of aquifers underlying the land within the area of Blue Mountains City Council.

SCHEDULE 2 – Water Restrictions

1. The taking of water pursuant to basic landholder rights under s52 of the *Water Management Act 2000* from the water sources defined in Schedule 1 for the following purposes is prohibited:
 - a. hosing of hard surfaces; and
 - b. for sprinklers or other watering systems.
 2. The restrictions in paragraph 1 apply only to landholdings supplied by reticulated water supply.
